


## A little look at what we do

The **Taste of Morland** weekend is intended as an introduction to Morland Choristers' Camp but it has taken on a life of its own as well.

**Morland Choristers' Camp** has taken place every year since 1971. The 48th Camp will take place **29 July – 5 August 2018.**

### Who is Taste of Morland for?

We have room for **up to 40 children aged 6-12 years of age** and try to have equal numbers of boys & girls.

**For security, feeding, etc.** there should be a **nominated adult** (parent, teacher, choir trainer) responsible for each child. One adult can be responsible for more than one child. We usually find that these people are very keen to make themselves useful; boosting the singing and seeing to the meals, as well as looking after the children in their free time.

This year we hope to have a few **'senior' choristers.** These will have been to Taste of Morland before and will be able to help the youngest members with singing and general activities.

### Who runs it?

Taste of Morland takes place at **Newby End Farm,** home of **Jenny and David Jones.**

We will be singing under the expert guidance of **Emma Richardson.** Emma grew up in Wigton, Cumbria before studying Music at the University of Huddersfield followed by training in Secondary Education. She currently teaches at Dowdales School, Dalton-in-Furness.



Over the past three years, she has been seconded to the Cumbria Music Education Hub as Area Development Manager for the Furness area, working with large groups of primary students to create performance events at local theatre spaces. Emma is thoroughly looking forward to returning to Taste of Morland again this year.

There is a charge of **£35 per child** to cover tutors, music, food and administration, or **£20 for senior choristers** in view of their extra responsibilities. *Please send this with your application.*
