From the Vicarage

In the early days of lockdown there was a lot of talk about it being an opportunity for healing. For the first time in many decades, the whole of life slowed right down, gave us time to think, stopped us from rushing around, buying things or doing stuff. We heaved a collective sigh and determined that we should not simply go back to the old way of doing things, but should learn the lessons of lockdown. I wonder whether we have changed, or whether we are simply now racing back to the way we did everything before. From my perspective it feels as though there is a great pressure to get everything going again as soon as possible, but perhaps now is actually the best possible time to review the lessons learned in lockdown and to begin to live differently. After all, now is the time when we are building the post-lockdown world and putting our learning into practice.

I can understand the rush back to the way things were. Doing everything a new way during lockdown was challenging and exhausting. Nothing could be done quickly or as a matter of routine. Everything had to be thought through from scratch. When you do something new, you make more mistakes and making mistakes can be embarrassing, perhaps even humiliating. It hits your confidence and there is an understandable desire to go back to what you know you were good at. And by the time we've thrown in the people we've missed and the activities we love, it can begin to look a bit like the old frantic way of life again.

But now is an opportunity to pause and reflect, to start building the different life we dreamed of in those early lockdown days when it was just a relief to step off the merry-go-round for a bit. What did we learn? I hope that we perhaps learned that we don't need to buy so much stuff, or throw so much away (as a family of four adults, we managed to halve the amount of rubbish we were putting out — it's gone back up now!) I hope that we learned that time spent with people is the most valuable time of all. I know that many of us prayed more and valued spending more time with God (not just the usual suspects!). I hope we learned that the gift of life is more precious than what we do, what we consume or what we buy. At the same time, I suspect we learned that we cannot just spend all our time in leisure, that having purpose and meaning in what we do is important for our own welfare as well as for what we can contribute to others. I think we also learned the value of community and loving our neighbour. And I suspect that lockdown highlighted the fact that just rushing around from one experience to another was disguising what we really need, something we perhaps had to confront during those long weeks when life took on a different perspective. No doubt there were other lessons, particular to you.

So perhaps now, as life opens up again and things become possible once more, we can restrain the instinct to rush headlong back to the old way of life and take time to complete the healing, to live a little longer with things being provisional and makeshift, while we take stock of what really matters in our lives. By doing so, perhaps we can build a future that helps us to nurture that which is most precious, in ourselves, in our communities and in creation. I am praying for us all as we do so.
