From the Vicarage

How do you stay positive? It's something that's been a particular challenge ever since lockdown began. And I find it becomes more tricky when November hits, the nights draw in and summer's lease comes to its end date all too soon, to paraphrase the Bard of Avon. When I was younger I fought quite a few battles against depression and the advice I received seemed to centre around the power of positive thinking. But very often it was my thinking that was the problem. Whichever way I thought about it merely seemed to confirm that I was quite right to worry! And the idea that my depression was the result of my own lack of willpower only made me feel a bigger failure.

Of course, there are good practical things you can do to keep positive. Getting exercise, eating healthily, playing with a dog, or a child, seeing friends, having creative things to do and distracting your mind are all good strategies. And, as I discovered, there are times when it's a good idea to take medication, provided we do it under the doctor's advice. But many of these things have been harder to do since lockdown.

I find that what keeps me truly positive is to have a genuine hope for the future, a hope that is not dependent on my effort, or my success or failure. November in the Church calendar is the season when we focus on the Kingdom of God. The Kingdom, in brief summary, is the restoration of creation as it should be when God is back in charge (as king). According to the Bible, the fundamental problem with the creation is that, having been given freewill by God, we chose to walk away from him and the consequences of that decision have been devastating, unpredictable and far-reaching. Instead of order, we have produced a world of fairly random chaos. In place of close, loving, committed relationships, we have a world of indifference, where increasingly we forget what it is to be loved or to love. In place of life, continuously renewed by our creator, we have a long slow wind-down to inevitable death. No wonder we get miserable from time to time!

But the good news at the heart of the Christian faith is that Jesus came to restore the Kingdom of God. In his death on the Cross, he took upon himself all the consequences of our decision to wander away from God. And in his resurrection, he offered a complete re-boot of life. We can start again, with God as our King. The consequences of accepting that gift and seeking to live God's way is immediate. Order begins to return to our chaos. Love begins to wipe out the years of harm caused by its absence. And we get to live meaningful, purposeful lives, sharing in the great work of re-ordering things back to God's will. Whether that's helping to reconcile souls to God and to one another, helping to restore the creation and its inhabitants, working for justice, caring for the vulnerable or under-valued, or just feeding on God's word and finding deep satisfying food for our souls, life is just so much better, straight away. Personally, I can't imagine living without it. And best of all, it guarantees our future. The Kingdom is the ultimate destiny of creation and we are invited to be part of it, right now in our daily lives, and forever. That means that our future, in this world and the next, is exciting, hopeful and meaningful. It means that what we do now matters eternally and eternity is something to look forward to. It means that our future is not dependent on our own effort, but upon our willingness to live under God's just, gentle, kind rule. It means that our best days are always before us and that really can make us cheerful, grateful and hopeful. Happy November to you all! Stewart







Take Positive Steps to Avoid Trips and Falls

People of all ages fall. However, the consequences of falling for older people can be serious. Falling due to aging is not inevitable, there are simple things we can do to minimize risk.

- Get regular exercise to improve strength, fitness and balance.
- Have your eyes and hearing checked. Vision and hearing play a vital role in balance and movement.
- Ask your pharmacist or GP for an annual medication review.
 Some medicines or illnesses, such as poorly controlled diabetes, can make you feel faint or dizzy.
- Look after your feet. Painful feet and ill-fitting shoes can affect your balance and increase the risk of falling.
- Make sure you get enough calcium and vitamin D to keep bones strong.
- Check your homes for trip hazards. Some risks are obvious, but often overlooked, such as clutter or poor lighting.

Making small adjustments in your daily life doesn't mean that you have to limit your activities. In fact, it can give you greater freedom and confidence.

In Flanders Field




